SUBJECT: **Restrictions on WY 22 (Wilson RM 6.0 – Idaho State Line RM 17.49) (Long Term)**

1. Loads on WY 22 are restricted to 60,000 pounds gross weight.
2. Between November 15 and April 1 no trailer traffic, including any towed units, is allowed.
3. Between April 2 and November 14 permitted loads will be allowed when road conditions are dry and favorable.
4. Loads in excess of the posted limit may be allowed (West bound only) when permitted by the Highway Patrol Office in Jackson (307)733-3869.

This is an updated memo for 2018 and replaces Memo #17-01 (Revision), which should be removed from your book.
