RE:

Update to "Operating on Notarized Bill of Sale" Memo dated August 7, 2003

There has been a request for the department to update the above mentioned memorandum reflecting the current statutory requirements for the length of time a transferee has to operate a vehicle on a properly executed title, notarized bill of sale or dealer's invoice.

QUESTION 1: When shall a person operate on a notarized bill of sale?

- A) When a title is being held by a bank or other financial institution and the title is not available at the time the vehicle is delivered. The transferor shall provide a dealer's invoice or a signed notarized bill of sale to the transferee, and the transferee shall deliver the title within thirty (30) days of the date of sale pursuant to W.S. 31-2-104(h)(i).
- B) When a vehicle auctioneer transfers ownership of a vehicle in the course of his business as a vehicle auctioneer. The auctioneer shall deliver to the transferee at the time the vehicle is delivered a signed, notarized bill of sale, and shall deliver the title to the transferee within thirty (30) days of the date of sale pursuant to W.S. 31-2-104(h)(ii).
 - > In both instances, the transferee has 60 days to operate on a notarized bill of sale or dealer's invoice pursuant to W.S. 31-2-201(a)(ii).

QUESTION 2: When shall a person operate on the title only?

- A) When ownership transfers and the title is <u>not held</u> by a bank or other financial institution or not transferred from an auctioneer of vehicles. The title is to be dated and delivered to the transferee at the time of delivering the vehicle pursuant to W.S. 31-2-104(a).
 - In this instance, the transferee has 45 days to operate on a properly executed title pursuant to W.S. 21-2-201(a)(ii).
