The Wyoming Department of Transportation's Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) is now accepting Statements of Intent for Fiscal Year 2025 projects.

## Applications must be completed in two steps.

<u>Step one</u> is the completion of a Statement of Intent (SOI) and site visit (the SOI form will be mailed by the Local Government Coordination (LGC) Office). **Statements of Intent (SOI) will be accepted between Friday, March 1, 2024, and Monday, April 15, 2024.** During the end of April and throughout the month of May, LGC will be conducting site visits to present the application, gather more information about your proposed project, and answer any questions about the program and process.

<u>Step two</u> of the process is the completion of the application. The application will be <u>available Friday</u>, <u>May 31, 2024, and due Monday, July 15, 2024</u>. Applications will only be available to those entities who have completed an SOI and site visit. LGC will accept applications for review on a first-come, first-serve through Monday, July 1, 2024. Incomplete applications will not be accepted or considered for funding.

Please note that <u>someone employed by your entity MUST complete the Local Public Agency (LPA)</u> <u>Certification prior to applying for funding</u>. The next certification course will be held on Wednesday, April 17, 2024, in Casper. To register, click the link below:

There have been no changes to eligible projects at the federal level (eligible activities can be found <u>here</u>). However, Wyoming's TAP funding priorities are: to facilitate the construction of Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) upgrades, the development of ADA transition plans, to provide safe routes for non-drivers, and to construct pedestrian and bicycle facilities.
