What Is The Process To Obtain A State Assigned VIN?

- 1. Obtain an application (Form MV-401) from any Wyoming County Clerk or Treasurer's office
- 2. Get a VIN inspection from Law Enforcement indicating "NO VIN" or listing the Multiple VIN numbers. (Please note that no VIN inspection is required on a trailer made from a pick-up box.)
- 3. Apply to WYDOT for the State Assigned VIN \$20.00
- 4. WYDOT will assign a number and you must have the number stamped onto the vehicle. (The State Assigned VIN will start with an "S" and end with a "W")
- 5. Get a second VIN inspection from Law Enforcement indicating the new VIN has been die punched onto the vehicle \$10.00
- 6. Take the WYDOT paperwork and second VIN inspection to your local County Clerk to receive a title \$15.00. (The county may need a weight slip to determine the weight of the trailer).
