

WYOLINK OPERATIONS WORK GROUP REPORT

June 3, 2009

WYOLINK Operations committee met April 20, 2009. Minutes of the March 9th meeting were reviewed and approved.


The Elk Mountain Interchange Site was discussed. That placement would give coverage over 17 miles of the 20-mile multi-path area at a cost of approximately \$480 thousand dollars. After explaining the situation, the Wyoming Highway Patrol presented accident records for 2008 showing there were 28 accidents in the 3-mile sections where the coverage was not good. WYDOT would have problems in the same areas as well as other users on the system.

The work group decided additional testing should be completed in this area to eliminate the coverage problems in the Elk Mountain Area of I 80.

Gillette police department made a request to connect their proposed 800 MHz system to the WYOLINK system. Motion was made to accept the request and carried by a voice vote.

Portable radio testing was discussed as well as the plans for Fremont, Hot Springs and Albany counties. Platte County has been completed with preliminary results showing better coverage with WYOLINK than they had before.

We received an update on the Cheyenne water tank site. Union telephone is looking for a replacement generator. A new generator will be delayed until June. Bob told us radio frequencies for this site are progressing through NTIA and we should be receiving allocations within a month.

Interoperability Executive Committee Phone Conference Meeting June 1, 2009

PSCC Administrative Support Bob Symons called the Phone Conference meeting to order at 2:32 pm..

On the Phone conference call was: Mark Harshman, Bob Dean, Marty McCoy, Steve Myrum, Lauri Wempen, Lanny Applegate, Danny Glick, Dale Pawling and Bob Symons.

WyoLink Applications

Discussion on the WyoLink applications that have been received since March 2009. There are two new applications, Carbon County Sheriff's Office and Bureau of Land Management - Wyoming. Bob Symons recommended the approval of the applications. **Marty McCoy made a motion to recommend approval of the applications to the PSCC, seconded by Bob Dean. The motion passed on a voice vote.**

Gov Delivery

Marty McCoy presented information on notification system, Gov Delivery. This will allow the delivery of information via text messages and email. WYDOT is currently using the system in the Transportation Management Center and WyoLink will be able to use the program at no cost. The system will be segment the messages by county and type. The users will be able to select the type of messages they wish to receive and by their county area. The system will be used to disseminate information pertaining to WyoLink functionality and outages. **Dale Pawling made a motion to move forward with the Gov Delivery message notification system. Lauri Wempen seconded the motion. The motion passed on a voice vote.**

Bob Symons informed the committee of the work that is being done to improve the interoperability section of the WyoLink Handbook for clarification on when and how to use WyoLink and other conventional channels for interoperability between agencies. This handbook revision will be presented to the Interoperable Executive Committee before the September PSCC meeting.

Training

Lanny Applegate stated the Fire Marshal's Office has two trained trainers ready to start training end users on WyoLink and Interoperability. The Wyoming Law Enforcement Academy has six trainers that have completed the training.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:43 pm.

WyoLink Support Manager's Report to the PSCC

June 3, 2009

WyoLink still has 40 sites active, with the 41st scheduled to come on line at Narrows Hill in the next two weeks. Volunteers continue to drive and test WyoLink, and these reports are being compiled by WYDOT Telecommunications and submitted to the WyoLink Support Office for review.

Motorola, WyoLink and representatives from the Forest Service and Power Companies will be walking five sites to finalize plans and work schedules for this summer. The sites that will be walked are Snow King, Windy Ridge, Hell Hole, Salt Pass and Pinkham Mountain.

The WyoLink Office is working closely with Right of Way and the US Forest Service to keep the Special Use Permits on track for the sites in the Big Horn and Bridger Teton National Forests. Construction will begin at Jelm Mountain this spring as soon as the WYDOT Microwave Shop obtains the necessary equipment. Bid documents are being prepared for the reflector at Dome Peak, and that permit should be in hand this week.

New consoles have been cut over at the Sheridan PD and Park County, and cut overs are scheduled for Fremont County and Niobrara County in the coming weeks.

Motorola is preparing summaries and maps of the portable coverage testing that was conducted in Platte, Fremont, Hot Springs and Albany Counties.

WyoLink and Motorola are working on a loading analysis to determine how much system capacity will be necessary to handle the anticipated voice and data traffic as more low speed data is utilized on the WyoLink system.

The Cheyenne Water Tank site is waiting for the power upgrade by Union Wireless to be completed. After this upgrade is complete, the rest of the construction work at this site can be completed.

The summer construction season is here, and both Motorola and WyoLink are poised to make the most of this season.
