Region 46 – Wyoming 800 MHz Regional Planning Committee September 25, 2009 Phone Conference Call Meeting

Mark Joiner called the phone conference meeting to order at 11:05 am

Utah Communications Agency Network (UCAN) Region 46 Coordination

Discussion on four requests from UCAN for approval of mobile relay facilities at Red Spur Mountain, China Ridge, Laketown, and Elizabeth Mountain. The Wyoming 800 MHz plan is used to prioritize the use of the 800 MHz frequencies. The unassigned frequencies are on a first come first serve basis and Wyoming reviews the frequencies but con not keep other regions from licensing the unassigned frequencies.

Red Spur Mountain – The request for concurrence is for five pairs of frequencies, two which are unassigned. There are three pairs of frequencies that are assigned, one pair in Natrona County, one pair in Converse County and one pair in Hot Springs County. The propagation maps provided indicate no interference on any of the assigned frequencies.

China Ridge – This request is for one pair of frequencies and that pair is assigned in Big Horn County, Crook County and Sublette County. The propagation maps provided do not indicate any propagation into Sublette County.

Laketown – This request is for five frequency pairs, three pairs are unassigned in Wyoming. One pair of the requested frequencies is assigned to Niobrara County and the other pair is assigned to Laramie County.

Elizabeth Mountain - This request is for five frequency pairs, three pairs are unassigned in Wyoming. One pair of the requested frequencies is assigned to Sheridan County and the other pair is assigned to Albany County.

Dan Perko stated there is probably no ground for objection to the requests. The Sublette County assigned pair is the closest county to any of the proposed sites. The 5 dBu coverage prediction does show some coverage from China Ridge into the southern part of Sublette County. The problem going forward will be the availability of the unassigned pairs for use in Wyoming.

Dan Perko made a motion to request UCAN search for an unassigned pair to replace the assigned frequency for Sublette County. The motion was seconded by Mark Joiner. The motion passed on a voice vote.

Dan Perko made a motion to approve the applications for concurrence for the Red Spur, Laketown and Elizabeth Mountain sites. The motion was seconded by Dave Adsit. The motion passed on a voice vote.

Being no further business, Mark Joiner adjourned the meeting at 11:21 am.
