

Appendix C. 2018 Project Addendum

On June 13, 2018, the Federal Railroad Administration approved the addition of the following project to the 2015 Statewide Rail Plan.

Project Title	Granger Junction Railroad Rehabilitation
Short Project Description	The Granger Junction Rehabilitation project will provide freight mobility across the complex 5-track crossing, which is currently impeded by a severe vertical alignment (hump) condition. The project is located is western Sweetwater County at the convergence of Union Pacific's Pocatello and Evanston Subdivisions. This work will consist of elevating a house track almost three feet to match the other four tracks, replacing and widening all five crossing surfaces, raising and extending the approaches to eliminate the hump condition, as well as signing and marking. Once the project is complete, safe and efficient access will be available and open to rail-served industrial properties north of the crossing. It will also be available to serve as a detour route should the adjacent highway-rail separation be rehabilitated or replaced.
