As a result of the testing completed in accordance with the Project 25 Compliance Assessment Program Baseline Common Air Interface Testing Requirements (P25-CAB-CAI_TEST_REQ), Tait TB9100, TM9100, TP9160 and TP9400 radios are compatible with the WyoLink system and are compliant with Project 25 Standards.

This is documented by both Summary and Detailed test reports that have been received by the WyoLink Support Office, and substantiated by the posting of these Summary Test Documents on the Responder Knowledge Base (RKB). These test reports have been reviewed and document that Tait TB9100, TM9100, TP9160 and TP9400 radios are compliant with Project 25 Standards.

As a result of this and operational testing performed on the WyoLink system by the WyoLink Support Office, the WyoLink Support Manager deems Tait TB9100, TM9100, TP9160 and TP9400 radios certified to be used on the WyoLink system.

All equipment offered under this certification and the Pre Negotiated Pricing Structure that has any trunking, encryption, or data features is guaranteed by the vendor to comply with the mandatory sections of the corresponding Project 25 Standards dealing with those features included at time of delivery. Only technical features vital to the operation of the tested radio on WyoLink were evaluated. Other features, service arrangements, and other comprehensive terms and conditions must be negotiated between the contracting agency and the vendor. It is the responsibility of the vendor to certify to the purchaser that the equipment price offered under the Pre Negotiated Pricing Structure remains at or below that of their current WSCA or GSA pricing structures.

Only vendor equipment that has been WyoLink certified will remain on the Pre Negotiated Pricing Agreement; if a vendor changes their equipment substantially in a manner that could affect P25 Compliance Assessment Program test results, it is the responsibility of the vendor to re certify their equipment. Documentation and test articles shall be certified before offering such equipment for operation on WyoLink.
