

## Submitting Asphalt Binder to Authorized Supplier List (ASL)

**Purpose:** Assist asphalt suppliers in submitting all necessary documentation for the Authorized Supplier List (ASL), previously known as the Qualified Products List (QPL). Ensure you read and understand the “Authorized Suppliers Guidelines\_Performance Graded Asphalt Binder (PGAB)” posted on WYDOT’s website as this document will only cover the submission of your product’s documentation.

**Submission:** Submit all necessary documentation via email attachments to WYDOT’s Asphalt and Chemistry Engineer.

**QC Plan:** After the initial year of the ASL implementation (2025), ensure QC Plans are updated, if applicable, to reflect ASL compliance rather than QPL compliance. Leeway will be given for 2025 submissions due to the timeline of the ASL implementation.

**Temperature and Viscosity Charts:** No change in requirements from the QPL process. See “Documentation (General), below.

**Specific Gravity:** No change in requirements from the QPL process. See “Documentation (General), below.

**Phosphorus Content:** No change in requirements from the QPL process. See “Documentation (General), below.

**Binder Test Data (COA):** No change in requirements from the QPL process. See “Documentation (General), below.

**Documentation (General):** To assist in both the supplier submission and agency review of documentation: For any supplier that is submitting asphalt binders for both AASHTO M320 and AASHTO M332 (MSCR) where the products themselves are identical (i.e. PGAB 58-28 is the same products as 58S-28), you may include both products in the header of the test reports; temperature and viscosity, specific gravity, phosphorus content and binder data (COA). This will limit the number of tests and submissions necessary for the ASL process. Please note that the required MSCR tests, Non-Recoverable Creep Compliance ( $J_{nr}$ ) and Percent Recovery (%R) must be included in the test data (COA) to be approved under AASHTO M332 (MSCR).

**Approval and Expiration:** No change in procedure from the QPL process. Products will be effective from the time of approval plus one calendar year. Expiration dates will be present on ASL form.

**Posting Authorized Suppliers:** List of approved supplies will be posted to the following web address and updated to reflect added suppliers and/or products.
