Notice of Award

On Thursday, October 21, 2021, the Wyoming Transportation Commission approved funding for the Fiscal Year 2022 Local Programs projects. Programs included in the funding are Transportation Alternatives, Congestion Mitigation Air Quality, and High-Risk Rural Road. All awards are federally funded with a required cash match from the Awardee.
