## Notice of Award

On Thursday, October 20, 2022, the Wyoming Transportation Commission approved funding for the Fiscal Year 2023 Local Programs projects. Programs included in the funding are Transportation Alternatives, Congestion Mitigation Air Quality, and High-Risk Rural Roads. All awards are federally funded with a required cash match from the Awardee.

The total federal contribution to the awards is as follows:

- TA - \$9,128,200;
- CMAQ - \$2,000,000;
- HRRR - \$506,629
