

Who needs a State Assigned VIN?

Trailers /Mobile Homes

- A homemade trailer with no VIN (ie: pick-up bed box trailer, homemade flatbed, etc.)
- A factory made trailer/mobile home with no VIN (ie: boat trailer vin sticker has fallen off or is unreadable, can't find VIN on a mobile home; etc.)

Motor Vehicles (Only completed/drivable motor vehicles)

- A motor vehicle with more than one VIN (ie: two vehicles were combined to make one vehicle)
- A motor vehicle with no VIN (ie: can't find VIN on motor vehicle)
- A motor vehicle modified to remove a part where the VIN appears (ie: driver's door with the VIN sticker has been replaced)
- A motor vehicle modified to include a part containing a different VIN (ie: dashboard with VIN number has been put on existing vehicle)

Who does NOT need a State Assigned VIN

- If a vehicle is modified from one style to another style, and the VIN is still on the vehicle, go to the County Clerk and County Treasurer and have the change the body code on both the title and the registration. (IE: House trailer modified to a flatbed trailer.)
