ADDENDUM TO STATE MANAGEMENT PLAN SECTION 1.5.5

Effective Date: June 1, 2025

Changes to Section 1.5.5 of the State Management Plan:

New - Mission Statement: The Wyoming Transit Advisory Committee (WyTAC) is a volunteer committee, to advise the Wyoming Department of Transportation's Transit Program on public transit policies and priorities. The WyTAC is charged with evaluating applications, recommending levels of service, identifying funding unmet public transit needs, and seeking maximum coordination of resources.

Omit – WYDOT is in the process of forming the Wyoming Transit Advisory Committee (WyTAC).

New (replace sentence above with the following) – WYDOT formed the Wyoming Transit Advisory Committee in May of 2025.

Update – Each committee member has the terms as listed below, and each member will be limited to serving two (2) consecutive terms. Members of the committee will include representatives from the following organizations:

- WYDOT Local Government Coordinator (*Chair and Tie-Breaking Vote*) (*No term expiration*)
- *Update* – WYDOT Office of Civil Rights (*Advisory Only – Non-Voting*) (*2-year term*)
- *Omit* – Directors Appointee (DBE/Civil Rights)
- Wyoming Institute for Disabilities (WIND) (*3-year term*)
- *Omit* – Wyoming Governor's Council on Developmental Disabilities
- *Omit* – Wyoming Department of Family Services – Adult Protection Program
- Wyoming Department of Health – Aging Division (*5-year term*)
- Wyoming Association of Municipalities (WAM) (*3-year term*)
- Wyoming County Commissioners Association (WCCA) (*3-year term*)
- *Update* - State Transit Association Board Member (*Advisory Only – Non-Voting*) (*2-year term*)
- *New* – Wyoming Department of Workforce Services (*5-year term*)
- *New* – Wyoming 211 (*3-year term*)

New – WyTAC is a seven-member committee with the WYDOT Local Government Coordinator only voting in the event of a tie. Each committee member is nominated by the director (or their designee) of the entity they represent.
